## **Biblical Learning after Wednesday Night Worship:**

### **Stream 1: "Traces of the Cross" with Pastor Robert Voigt**

"Our annual Lenten walk from Ash Wednesday to Easter does not require us to seek some kind of emotional experience in order to appreciate the grace of God. When we allow the Word of God to teach us, we find that God had a plan from the beginning and that he would stick to that plan, no matter how many times his people got in the way.

Join me as we **Trace God's Plan to the Cross**, and receive renewed assurance that *God loved the world so much that he sent his only Son . . .*" (Pastor Robert)

### **Stream 2: "A Living Faith" with Pastor Adrian Kitson**

Lent has long been a "spring time for the soul. It is a time to take stock of one's life and invite the Lord to renew us in our following of Jesus. "A Living Faith" is a Lenten journey for those new to the Faith, new to St Petri or those who sense that it may be time to prepare to renew their Confirmation vows.

We will walk through **A Living Faith** (Luther's Small Catechism in an adult way) and focus in on the very foundations of our life in Christ.

Those seeking to more deeply belong to St Petri by being **welcomed into Membership** will have opportunity to do this.

Those wishing to **renew their confirmation vows** will be able to do that. Those just wishing to remember and re-learn and enjoy getting back to basics can do that too!
