

## VISION - WHAT WE BELIEVE ABOUT GOD & WORSHIP

Worship is a conversation between God and us. He speaks to us and we respond to him in thanks, praise and the giving of ourselves.

## COMMITMENT EXPECTATIONS

### Committed to Jesus

We ask our musicians to be followers of Jesus and behave in a way that is consistent with the message of Jesus.

### Committed to St. Petri

We ask our musicians to be regular and committed members of St. Petri. For newer members this would include participation in at least one adult learning journey that St. Petri runs through the year and participation in the St. Petri Foundations Lunch for people newer to the community.

We ask our musicians to grow in Christian maturity in the context of a Christian community. As such, in order of priority, your first commitment will be to this community followed by commitment to music.

Therefore, St. Petri musicians should attend worship and participate as part of the congregation when they are not playing. We recognise there are times when we can't be at worship, but hope this would be the exception rather than the norm.

### Committed to Service

We ask our musicians to commit to being a servant of others for the good of the rest of the church. This means being teachable, correctable, humble and being willing to forsake personal preferences for the sake of the broader vision.

We ask our musicians to submit to and support their leaders.

We ask our musicians, if it is possible, to work for peace in relationships within the music department, in the broader church community and all communities of which they are a part.

### Committed to Skill Development

We ask our musicians to be prepared. As such they should commit to the ongoing learning of their craft such as the Biblical and spiritual foundations for our Liturgy and worship life, music theory, vocal and instrumental musicianship and leadership skills. This should be through individual education and practice and group rehearsal.

We ask our musicians to participate in regular training sessions such as 'All Ins'.

We ask our musicians to come to rehearsals well-rehearsed, on time and ready to play. As such, and in order to maintain our commitment to excellence, our intention is to maintain a 'no rehearsal - no play' policy.
