Happy Together.

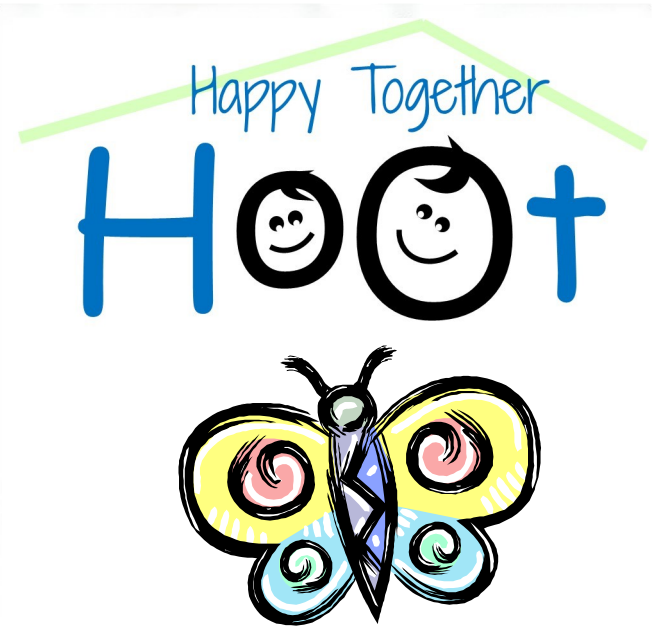
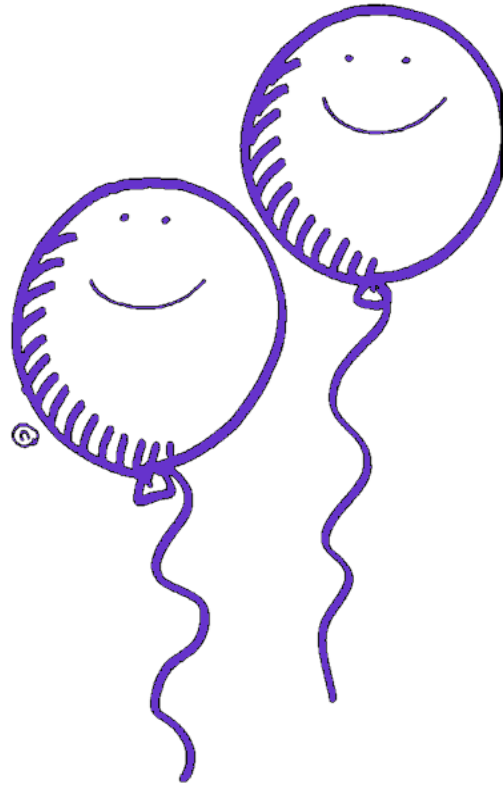
Child Safe Information
